Suggested actions and movement

- Make a witch action with thumb and index finger pulling away from the nose in a point.
 Then pretend to ride a broom around the room.
- Make black cat action using both hands in front of the body and closing them like cat's claws.

 Then move around the room like a cat.
- Make a monster action with arms and hands loosely held out in front of body and a monsterous looking expression on the face! Then move around the room slowly like a monster.
- Spread arms out wide to make a ghost action then move around the room flying like a ghost.
- Hide face behind hands and make a peekaboo action showing a scary expression on the face then enjoy moving around the room scaring all the Halloween things away to finish!

Suggested adaptations

Halloween can be quite frightening for really little ones, so enjoy making some funny faces and actions for your little one and playing some peekaboo to finish the song.

Focus word: Halloween ~ Halloween (hah-loh-win)



Cauldron or large bowl, large box of bicarbonate of soda, water, large bottle of white vinegar, food colouring, plastic bugs, wooden spoons, ladle, smaller bowls.

- 1. Pour around 800ml of water into the bowl (depending on the size of your 'cauldron')
- 2. Add food colouring, 3 heaped tbsp of bicarbonate of soda and plastic bugs if you have them.
- 3. Stir it up, then add tablespoons of vinegar at a time and watch it start to fizz!
- 4. Children can continue to add bicarb of soda and vinegar to enjoy the fizzing until you run out!
- 5. Add an element of role play by 'serving out the brew' to friends or family imagining what effect it will have!

 Ensure children don't drink it of course!
