



Mundo Helado Activity - 1.1 El frío y el calor ~ Cold & Hot Activity Notes

To set up this activity:

1. Print out the following two pages
2. Cut out each item and hide them around your setting or home. They can be placed in envelopes if you like to add extra excitement and FMS practice, or simply dotted around the space.
3. Make a central space in the room where children can bring back each item and classify it under the words 'Frío ~ Cold' or 'Calor ~ Hot'.
4. Enjoy discussing each item and listening to their views, some items aren't always one or the other, so this activity can spark some really interesting discussion around the topic.



Spanish info to note

Frío is fairly straightforward in Spanish to describe the cold, but when an object IS cold it's more complex than a direct English translation:

'es frío' - something that is permanently cold

'está frío' - something that is cold right now, but can be heated or cooled

For **cold weather** it's: **'hace frío'**, just like in the song for this session.

And if you're **feeling cold** it's: **'tengo frío'** ~ I am cold

In this activity we are using the word **'calor'** which means **heat** in Spanish rather than 'hot'.

To describe an item as hot, use **'caliente'** instead.

Calor is used like this:

For **hot weather**: **'hace calor'** - the opposite of 'hace frío'.

If you're **feeling hot** it's: **'tengo calor'** ~ I am hot ~ literally translated to I have heat.
