This lesson's song

Focus word: snow - la nieve (lah nyeh-beh)

Snowfall ~ Cae la nieve

(To the tune of 'Skip to my Lou')

Suggested actions & movement



Start by making a snow fall down action by bring both hands down from up high in front of the body and wiggling fingers at the same time.



Next, squeeze hands together to make a crunching/squeezing action.



Then, move around the room leaving snowy footprints ~ huellas.



Finish by repeating the snow falling action from the first verse.



Suggested adaptations

Gently tickle from baby's head to toes to show falling snow.

• Use a foil blanket or similar to make a crunching sound for baby to hear.

 Lift baby up to standing and bounce their feet gently on the ground to make footprints - huellas!



You could use props in this song such as artificial snowflakes to pick up and make fall, foil blankets to walk on and make a crunching sound and even some flour sprinkled onto a covered area or tuff try to make footprints.

Resources required:

- Optional sensory equipment
 - Artificial snowflakes
 (paper or felt eg)
 - Foil blankets or similar
 - Flour for footprints



Observation Opportunities

Copy gestures and words ie snow falls, la nieve cae

Give focused attention to what the teacher says by performing actions at correct time.

Use large muscle movements to copy actions

Understand some of the characteristics of snow.

Take part in simple pretend play
- imagining snow and leaving
footprints.



Copos de nieve con pintura hinchada

Equipment: PVA Glue, Shaving Cream (equal measures of both), Silver or White Glitter, Bowl, Blue card,
Paintbrushes, White chalk, Snowflake examples

- I. Mix the glue and shaving cream together in a bowl to create a thick consistency, then mix in the glitter.
- 2. Show children snowflake examples, create a template using white chalk if necessary.
- 3. Paint snowflake pictures and leave to air dry.
- Y. Make a beautiful 'Copos de nieve ~ Snowflakes' display in the setting.
