Focus word: a flower ~ una flor (oo-nah flohr)

Actions

This session's song

Garden Flowers ~ Las flores del jardín

Suggested actions and movement

At the start of each verse

Hold up one finger, point to yourself and then down to the ground.

Flor ~ Flower actions

Margarita ~ Daisy

Spread palms out wide and twist wrists up and down.

Girasol ~ Sunflower

With both hands and arms held up in front of you, palms facing away from the face, twist wrists to make a turning action.

Tulipán ~ Tulip

Press palms together, then bend slightly at the knuckles, then bend wrists back and forth.

Rosa ~ Rose

Press palms together then band fingers outward keeping wrists as close together as possible.

Amapola ~ Poppy

Place one hand on top of the other with palms facing away from the body.

Suggested adaptations

- Sunflower - Arms up high in the air
- Tulip - Press palms together in front of you
- Rose - Clasp hands together
- Poppy - Make a fist

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Why not try...

Mosaic Flowers

Flores de mosaico



Equipment:

Flower Template - Basic flower shape drawn on coloured card
Brightly coloured card or paper including glittered if you like
Card circles - any colours for the centre.

Scissors
Glue Stick

Using one flower template for each child, let them cut small pieces of coloured card or paper and stick them down onto their flower template. The brighter the better!

For older babies who are ready for a crafty activity, provide them with pre cut shapes to stick down.

Let them choose a coloured circle for the centre of their flower and enjoy their beautiful art work!

This activity is great for developing fine motor skills, challenging older children to cut shapes, or create a pattern if they like.
